



FACILITY USAGE POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT: All members of Swan City Football Club (“SCFC”) will respect facilities used by the membership and/or teams.

PURPOSE: To ensure that all members of SCFC represent the association in a respectable manner while participating in team functions.

SCOPE: All members of SCFC and those associated or accompanying teams of SCFC.

DEFINITIONS: All City School gyms, Eastlink Centre, The Leisure Centre, Alliance Church, SCFC soccer Centre, or other SCFC facilities.

PROCEDURE/GUIDELINES: The indoor soccer facility limits the amount of practice time available to all members and leagues. The practice hours are subject to change based on the number of teams playing indoor soccer during the season. All indoor Field or Gym space allocated to teams needs to be utilized as committed. Refer to facility booking policy as well.

DRESSING ROOM USE: Users shall vacate the dressing rooms within ONE-HALF HOUR after the conclusion of their field rental time. If there are continuous instances that teams are not vacating dressing rooms on time, additional charges may be levied.

All facilities shall be left in an acceptable condition after each use or extra charges for damages or excessive clean up shall be applied. If an individual or team is found guilty of vandalism or property damage to a SCFC facility or one rented through SCFC (i.e. polluting shower stalls, damage to walls, graffiti, etc.) that individual or team will be responsible for all repair/cleaning costs incurred. A minimum fine of \$250.00 will be assessed and automatic ONE year minimum ban from entering all SCFC facilities and or subject to performance bonds and a probationary period.

DRESSING ROOM AND REFEREE ROOM KEYS: These are available for sign out at the front office and will be required to turn in their car keys prior to issuance. Keys will be issued 30 minutes prior to game/practice time and must be returned within 30 minutes of booking completion. Keys not returned will be subject to a \$100.00 lost key charge and payment must be made before the next league game or team practice.

SPITTING Spit is considered a bio-hazard and is unacceptable practice in any indoor facility. Players, members or spectators in violation of this are subject to fines and may be suspended or banned from facilities.

FIGHTING Outside field of play: If an individual is found guilty of fighting outside the field of play and within facility proximity, SCFC may assess an automatic ONE year minimum ban from entering all SCFC facilities and/or subject him or her to performance bonds and a probationary period. Further disciplinary action may be taken by the league in which he/she plays, in addition to the SCFC facility ban.

If altercations occur outside the field of play and specific individuals cannot be identified as participants, teams may be assessed one year performance bonds by SCFC. These bonds are payable, by cash or certified cheque only, to the Swan City Football Club.”

FOUL LANGUAGE: Use of obscene language, on or off the field will not be tolerated. Referees and Facility Attendants are instructed to deal with this immediately. Offenders outside field of play will be asked to leave the facility and have an incident report filed and Players will receive an automatic yellow or red card. Multiple infractions may result in facility suspension and fines.
